

Giovanni M. Pauletti is Associate Dean of Graduate Studies and Gustavus & Henry Pfeiffer Chair of the Department of Pharmaceutical and Administrative Sciences at the University of Health Sciences and Pharmacy in St. Louis, MO (USA). Since 2015, he serves as the FIP Scientific Secretary providing leadership and strategic direction for this global federation on scientific aspects relevant to pharmaceutical sciences, practice, and education. Dr. Pauletti received his M.S. in Pharmacy and Ph.D. in Biopharmaceutics from the School of Pharmacy at the Swiss Federal Institute of Technology (ETH) in Zurich, Switzerland. After completion of a postdoctoral fellowship at the University of Kansas, Lawrence, KS (USA), Dr. Pauletti began his academic career in 1997 at the Texas Tech University, School of Pharmacy in Amarillo, TX (USA). He currently directs an interdisciplinary research program that centers on the design and evaluation of novel drug delivery systems. In collaboration with various academic and commercial partners, he successfully enabled preclinical and early clinical development of those technologies to improve therapeutic applications of small molecules and biotechnology-based drugs. Dr. Pauletti has published more than 160 scientific papers and communications and is an inventor on 9 U.S. patents.
